

## **A Book for Camera Clubs**

“Always carry your camera” began as a series of short articles first published in a club magazine. The pieces proved very popular with beginners. As a result of this popularity it was decided to make something more durable and the idea of a book was born. Its purpose is to ease the perennial club problem of how to give an appropriate level of support to new members who are also complete beginners.

It is an introductory book on photography that takes the absolute beginner through the stages of understanding what the camera can and can't do. Then leading into how to compose the photograph so that it is not just a simple snapshot but something you could be proud to hang on the wall. Although targeted at new comers to camera clubs it is suitable for anyone who wants to take their photography to a level beyond the selfie and the simple camera phone snap. Finally there are short sections on what can be done with photo editing software and how you can mount and digitally display your pictures to advantage.

Guest pieces by Andy Sands on Macro Photography and Stan McCartin on the benefits of Camera Club Membership add variety. Over 70 photographs by 17 Camera Club members from 6 different clubs are used to illustrate each theme of the book.

It is an ideal starter book for clubs to hand out to beginners or sell at a small profit. It is available to all clubs from £5.50 each for batches of ten or more (including post & packing). It is also available on Amazon at just under £9.00 plus post and packing.
