PAGB Awards

Note: You may not contact the PAGB Awards Secretary before sending in your PAGB application form. All prior enquiries must be made to the CACC Awards Officer.

Note: Because there may be changes from time to time, always use a current version of this form, and always refer to current PAGB leaflets. Do not make and keep copies for future use.

Qualification

You qualify by being a current and active member of your Club. In addition, you must observe the time qualifications required by the PAGB for each level of award.

Current Member: At the time of application, you must be a member of your Club. If you have changed Clubs, then time and activity whilst a member of a previous Club can be included in your historical evidence: the same applies if you have changed federations. Your application is always made through your current Club.

Active Member: During the qualifying time period, you must have regularly attended your Club, and also have made work (as Prints, Slides, Projected Digital or Audio-Visual) available for selection or have submitted work directly to any of the following types of event. Events which are not ongoing can still be included in your historical evidence.

- Inter-Club events hosted by CACC (Inter-Club Championships, Best Panel of Prints at the Annual Exhibition, Chilterns Hundred Exhibition, Slide of the Year, Strictly Digital, RoseBowl Inter-Club Competition, Audio-Visual Trophy)
- Inter-Club events hosted by a CACC or other PAGB-affiliated Club
- Equivalent inter-Club events while you were a member of a Club in another Federation
- PAGB Inter-Federation Competition and Exhibitions
- PAGB Inter-Club events (Print Championship, Projected Championship, GB Trophies for Prints (Open, Nature), GB Cups for Projected (Open, Small Clubs, Nature))
- PAGB *masters of print* Competition and Exhibition
- BPE Exhibitions
- Competitions or Exhibitions with PAGB, FIAP, PSA or RPS Patronage

This range of events is deliberately wide. Attending and participating in events outside your own Club is an important part of your preparation for a PAGB Award.

How to apply

Application for awards is in three stages.

Stage one: Assemble the evidence of your club membership and activity. Complete your details on the Form overleaf. Ask your club chairman or secretary to sign the form. (See the separate guidance to clubs about verifying applications.) Send the completed and countersigned form to the CACC Awards Officer, as shown.

Stage two: You will receive a PAGB application form from the CACC Awards Officer. Complete and sign the PAGB application form, and send it, together with your cheque for the appropriate fee, to the PAGB Awards Secretary. The details are given on the form.

DO NOT SEND YOUR IMAGES WITH THE PAGB FORM.

Stage three: The PAGB Awards Secretary will now liaise with you directly concerning your application, the venue and arrangements for the adjudication, and when to submit your images.
