

PAGB Merit Awards

Guidelines for Club Chairmen / Secretaries to Approve Member Applications

1. The Member should have all the guidance notes and application forms prepared ready for your approval.
2. The PAGB Qualification rules are in the Awards for Photographic Merit leaflet. Always refer to the current edition.
3. Membership: Check that the member has been with your Club, or other Clubs, for the minimum period of activity (currently 2, 3 and 5 years for C, D, and MPAGB respectively). The qualifying period must have been within the past 10 years.
4. Activity: Check that the member has:
 - Attended regularly.
 - Made work available for at least one event (as shown in the CACC list) in each year of the PAGB qualifying period.

The member should provide you with adequate evidence of this activity. For example, a record of the titles, events and dates.

5. You may accept the Member's application on the basis of your personal knowledge of their activity. If you are unsure about anything then please contact the CACC Awards Officer.
